<b>ORGANIZATION</b>	<b>0-6 points</b> Audience cannot follow presentation - no logical sequence.	<b>7-12 points</b> Audience has difficulty following presentation because student jumps around.	<b>13-18 points</b> Presents information in logical sequence that audience can follow.	<b>19-24 points</b> Presents information in logical, interesting sequence that audience can follow.	
<b>CONTENT KNOWLEDGE</b>	<b>0-4 points</b> Does not have grasp of the information; cannot answer questions about the subject.	<b>5-8 points</b> Is uncomfortable with information and is able to answer only rudimentary questions.	<b>9-12 points</b> Is at ease with content, but fails to elaborate.	<b>13-16 points</b> Demonstrates full knowledge with explanations and elaboration. Full answers to all questions.	
<b>SLIDES</b>	<b>0-3 points</b> Uses no slides.	<b>4-6 points</b> Slides rarely support presentation.	<b>7-9 points</b> Slides related to presentation.	<b>10-12 points</b> Student uses slides effectively to reinforce presentation.	
<b>MECHANICS</b>	<b>0-2 points</b> Presentation has several spelling and/or grammatical errors.	<b>3-4 points</b> Presentation has a few misspellings and/or grammatical errors.	<b>5-6 points</b> Presentation has almost no misspellings and/or grammatical errors.	<b>7-8 points</b> Presentation has no misspellings or grammatical errors.	
<b>ELOCUTION</b>	<b>0-3 points</b> Mumbles, incorrectly pronounces terms, and speaks too softly for the audience in the back of the room to hear.	<b>4-6 points</b> Voice is low. Incorrectly pronounces terms. Audience members have difficulty hearing the presentation.	<b>7-9 points</b> Voice is clear. Pronounces most words correctly. Most audience members can clearly hear the presentation.	<b>10-12 points</b> Uses a clear voice and correct, precise pronunciation of terms. All members of the audience can hear presentation.	
<b>EYE CONTACT</b>	<b>0-2 points</b> Little or no eye contact with audience.	<b>3-5 points</b> Occasional eye contact but reads notes on slides most of the time.	<b>6-8 points</b> Maintains eye contact much of the time.	<b>9-10 points</b> Maintains eye contact with audience.	
<b>TIME MANAGEMENT</b>	<b>2 points</b> < 10 minutes or > 15 minutes.	<b>4 points</b> 10 to 12 minutes with no stalling or rushing.	<b>6 points</b> 12 to 14 minutes with no stalling or rushing.	<b>8 points</b> 14 to 15 minutes with no stalling or rushing.
